Martin Luther wrote the "Disputation on the Power and Efficacy of Indulgences,"

also known as

"The 95 Theses"

a list of questions and propositions for debate.

Popular legend has it that on October 31, 1517, Luther nailed a copy of his **95 Theses** to the door of the Wittenberg Castle church in Germany

After studying the books of Galatians and Romans Luther believed that the Bible is the central religious authority and that humans may reach **Salvation only by their Faith** and not by their deeds—was to spark the Protestant Reformation

Even though many others over the last 14 centuries believed this, **Martin Luther** sparked off the Reformation.

1598 April

Edict of Nantes

King Henry IV of France

Allowed Christians (Huguenots)

to freely worship

1685 October

Edict of Fontainebleau

was issued by King Louis IV of France

Revoking the **Edict of Nantes** Thus taking away the freedom of worship

1776 July 4

Declaration of the United States of America which includes these words:

<u>We</u> hold these truths to be self evident, That ALL MEN ARE CREATED EQUAL, that they are endowed by their CREATOR with certain <u>UNALIENABLE RIGHTS</u> that among these are LIFE, LIBERTY, AND THE PURSUIT OF HAPPINESS

Note our founding Fathers believed that all men are created by God. Secondly God gives certain rights *=unalienable rights* These are rights not given by the government and therefore no government has the right to take them away.

Amendment I

Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof, or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press, or the right of people peaceably to assembly, and to petition the Government for a redress of grievances

Our Founding Fathers established America as a **Republic** not a **Democracy**

Ben Franklin in reply to what form of government we have:

"YOU HAVE A REPUBLIC, IF YOU CAN KEEP IT"

The movement from a **Republic** to a **Democracy** occurred over a span of decades

as the Judicial system (Supreme Court)

slowly moved us from a **Republic** to a **Democracy**.
