Why Did JESUS CHRIST Come Into The World?

He came in reference to His Father

He came in reference to Satan

He came in reference to Mankind

JESUS CHRIST spoke, Himself, of the reasons for which He <u>did NOT come</u>.

1 He did not come to call the Righteous.

Matthew 9:13

"But go and learn what this means: 'I DESIRE COMPASSION, AND NOT SACRIFICE,' for I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners."

Mark 2:17

And hearing *this*, Jesus *said to them, "*It is* not those who are healthy who need a physician, but those who are sick; I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners."

2 He did not come to condemn or judge the world.

John 3:17

¹⁷ "For God did not send the Son into the world to judge the world, but that the world might be saved through Him.

John 12: 47

⁴⁷ and if you prefer to hear it from Himself of Himself.

"If anyone hears My sayings and does not keep them, I do not judge him; for I did not come to judge the world, but to save the world.

3 He did not come to abolish the Law or the prophets.

Matthew 5:17

"Do not think that I came to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I did not come to abolish but to fulfill.

4 He did not come to be served or waited upon.

Mark 10:45

45 "For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

5 He did not come of His own will or desire.

John 7:28

Then Jesus <u>cried out</u> in the temple, teaching and saying, "You both know Me and know where I am from; and I <u>have not come</u> of Myself, but He who sent Me is true, whom you do not know.

6 He did not come to do His own Will

John 6:38

³⁸ "For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me.

He came down from heaven and at His Ascension He will return to heaven and people, we were not born from here in our 2nd birth but from above and that is where we return.

So, here we have 6 reasons as to why He did <u>NOT</u> come from heaven; so, <u>let us look at the positive reasons why JESUS</u> CHRIST did come from heaven to earth in likeness of man.

I would like to insert right here **why?**

Why did God the Father send His Son JESUS CHRIST into the world?

Why JESUS CHRIST came to earth— in reference to His Father

1 First and Foremost – it was God the Father's will and desire that His Son, JESUS CHRIST come to earth!

John 8:42

Jesus said to them, "If God were your Father, you would love Me, for I proceeded forth and have come from God, for I have not even come on My own initiative, but He sent Me.

I think one reason so many try to put JESUS CHRIST over God the Father why they would prefer to pray to JESUS CHRIST than to God the Father is that they do not understand why JESUS CHRIST came in the first place—here we see clearly in His own words that God the Father sent JESUS CHRIST and that dear people is why He is here! This also teaches us why He is so intent on returning to God the Father.

2 Because of His own perfect Rightousness and man's Un-Righteousness—no relationship; but so He could have relationship with man.

Romans 3:25-26

- whom God displayed publicly as a propitiation in His blood through faith. *This was* to demonstrate His righteousness, because in the forbearance of God He passed over the sins previously committed;
- for the demonstration, *I say*, of His righteousness at the present time, so that He would be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.
- 3 Because of His Love.

John 3:16

"For in this manner God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have everlasting life.

1 John 4:10

In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son *to be* the propitiation for our sins.

4 Because of His Grace.

Hebrews 2:9

- But we do see Him who was made for a little while lower than the angels, *namely*, Jesus, because of the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, so that by the grace of God He might taste death for everyone.
- 5 God the Father sent His Son into the world to redeem us from the curse of the Law.

Galatians 4:4-5

- ⁴ But when the fullness of the time came, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the Law,
- ⁵ so that He might redeem those who were under the Law, that we might receive the adoption as sons.

2 Corinthians 3:6

5 ...the law kills. Ephesians 2:14 For He Himself is our peace, who made both groups into one and broke down the barrier of the dividing wall,

- For He Himself is our peace, who made both *groups into* one and broke down the barrier of the dividing wall,
- by abolishing in His flesh the enmity, which is the Law of commandments contained in ordinances, so that in Himself He might make the two into one new man, thus establishing peace,

Colossians 2:14

having canceled out the certificate of debt consisting of decrees against us, (Mosaic Law) which was hostile to us; and He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross.

6 God sent His Son into the world that He might bless us.

Acts 3:26

²⁶ "For you first, God raised up His Servant <u>and sent Him to bless</u> you by turning every one *of you* from your wicked ways."

7 One that we have already seen but under a different section: God the Father did not send His Son into the world to judge the world but that the world might be saved through Him

John 3:17

- ¹⁷ "For God did not send the Son into the world to judge the world, but that the world might be saved through Him.
- 8. This clearly states that JESUS CHRIST did not come into the world to judge the world, but He did come for Judgement—to be judged in the place of the world for sins.

John 9:39

- And Jesus said, "For judgment I came into this world, so that those who do not see may see, and that those who see may become blind."
- 9. God sent His Son to be the Propitiation for the world.

1 John 4:10

In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins.

10. JESUS CHRIST came into the world to fulfill Scripture.

Luke 7:20

When the men came to Him, they said, "John the Baptist has sent us to You, to ask, 'Are You the Expected One, or do we look for someone else?'

John 6:14

Therefore when the people saw the sign which He had performed, they said, "This is truly the Prophet who is to come into the world."

John 11:27

She *said to Him, "Yes, Lord; I have believed that You are <u>the</u> Christ, <u>the Son of God</u>, <u>even He who comes into the wo</u>rld."

John 18:37

Therefore Pilate said to Him, "So You are a king?" Jesus answered, "You say *correctly* that I am a king. For this I have been born, and <u>for this I have come into the world, to testify to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth hears My voice."</u>

He came to proclaim that He has come in fulfillment of Scripture:

He *said to them, "Let us go somewhere else to the towns nearby, so that I may preach/proclaim there also; for that is what I came for."

11. He came to fulfill all the Promises God had made about the One He would send.

Matthew 11:2-6

- Now when John, while imprisoned, heard of the works of Christ, he sent word by his disciples
- and said to Him, "Are You the Expected One, or shall we look for someone else?"
- Jesus answered and said to them, "Go and report to John what you hear and see:
- the BLIND RECEIVE SIGHT and the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear, the dead are raised up, and the POOR HAVE THE GOSPEL PREACHED TO THEM.
- 6 And blessed is he who does not take offense at Me."

- And the book of the prophet Isaiah was handed to Him. And He opened the book and found the place where it was written,
- "THE SPIRIT OF THE LORD IS UPON ME, BECAUSE HE ANOINTED ME TO PREACH THE GOSPEL TO THE POOR. HE HAS SENT ME TO PROCLAIM RELEASE TO THE CAPTIVES, AND RECOVERY OF SIGHT TO THE BLIND, TO SET FREE THOSE WHO ARE OPPRESSED,
- TO PROCLAIM THE FAVORABLE YEAR OF THE LORD."
- And He closed the book, gave it back to the attendant and sat down; and the eyes of all in the synagogue were fixed on Him.
- And He began to say to them, "Today this Scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing."
- 12. God promised a Messiah for the race of Jews and He came to fulfill this promise,

John 1:11

¹¹ He came to His own, and those who were His own did not receive Him.

For I say that Christ has become a servant to the circumcision on behalf of the truth of God to confirm the promises *given* to the fathers,

13. Christ came into the world to Glorify God the Father.

Romans 15:9

⁹ and for the Gentiles to glorify God for His mercy; as it is written, "THEREFORE I WILL GIVE PRAISE TO YOU AMONG THE GENTILES, AND I WILL SING TO YOUR NAME."

John 12:27-28

- "Now My soul has become troubled; and what shall I say, 'Father, save Me from this hour'? But for this purpose I came to this hour.
- "Father, glorify Your name." Then a voice came out of heaven:
 "I have both glorified it, and will glorify it again

John 17:4

⁴ "I glorified You on the earth, having accomplished the work which You have given Me to do.

Are you beginning to get perhaps an added understanding of why JESUS CHRIST desired to return to God the Father in His Ascension?

14. JESUS CHRIST came into the world to be the light of the world.

John 12: 46

- ⁴⁶ "I have come *as* Light into the world, so that everyone who believes in Me will not remain in darkness.
- 15. And pentacle of all that He came to fulfill the Scriptures that show that the Messiah had to suffer and then rise from the dead.

Isaiah 53:10

To crush Him, putting *Him* to grief;
If He would render Himself *as* a guilt offering,
He will see *His* offspring,
He will prolong *His* days,
And the good pleasure of the LORD will prosper in His hand.

Acts 8:30-35

Philip ran up and heard him reading Isaiah the prophet, and said, "Do you understand what you are reading?"

- And he said, "Well, how could I, unless someone guides me?"

 And he invited Philip to come up and sit with him.
- Now the passage of Scripture which he was reading was this:
 "He was led as a sheep to slaughter;
 And as a lamb before its shearer is silent,
 So He does not open His mouth.
- "IN HUMILIATION HIS JUDGMENT WAS TAKEN AWAY;
 WHO WILL RELATE HIS GENERATION?
 FOR HIS LIFE IS REMOVED FROM THE EARTH."
- The eunuch answered Philip and said, "Please *tell me*, of whom does the prophet say this? Of himself or of someone else?"
- Then Philip opened his mouth, and beginning from this Scripture he preached Jesus to him.

Acts 17:3

³ explaining and giving evidence that the Christ had to suffer and rise again from the dead, and saying, "This Jesus whom I am proclaiming to you is the Christ." 16. He came to Reveal God the Father to us; God the Father is Invisible (Colossians 1:15) so how are we to know God the Father? For this JESUS CHRIST came into the world.

Gospel of John 1:17-18

- ¹⁷ For the Law was given through Moses; grace and truth were realized through Jesus Christ.
- No one has seen God at any time; the only begotten God who is in the bosom of the Father, He has explained *Him*.
- 17. He came to speak the Words of God the Father.

Gospel of John 3:34; 7:16; 8:26; 14:24;

- For He whom God has sent speaks the words of God; for He gives the Spirit without measure.
- So Jesus answered them and said, "My teaching is not Mine, but His who sent Me.
- ^{8:26} I have many things to speak and to judge concerning you, but He who sent Me is true; and the things which I heard from Him, these I speak to the world."
- He who does not love Me does not keep My words; and the word which you hear is not Mine, but the Father's who sent Me.

Why JESUS CHRIST came to earth— in reference to Satan

During the Angelic Conflict Satan has continually attempted to usurp the authority and position of JESUS CHRIST to give himself equality with God the Father.

He started his attack against God in Eternity Past. Then in the Garden of Eden he tempted man to sin, and has been the ruler of the world ever since.

18 We have seen why JESUS CHRIST came to earth in reference to God the Father; but JESUS CHRIST also came to earth to destroy the works of the Devil.

1 John 3:8

the one who practices sin is of the devil; for the devil has sinned from the beginning. The Son of God appeared for this purpose, to destroy the works of the devil.

19. He came to earth to render powerless Satan's rule over believers.

Hebrews 2:14

Therefore, since the children share in flesh and blood, He Himself likewise also partook of the same, that through death He might render powerless him who had the power of death, that is, the devil,

I hope this has opened your eyes to a truth,
we have gone through several reasons why JESUS CHRIST
came into the world and they each have to do
with God the Father or the Word of God.
And in reference to Satan.

Now, let's note
WHY JESUS CHRIST CAME INTO THE WORLD
AS IT RELATES TO THE HUMAN RACE.

He came in reference to Mankind

There are two emphases to the Gospel.

NEGATIVE

The removal of man's sins by JESUS CHRIST. But this in and of itself does <u>NOT</u> result in man's salvation.

POSITIVE

There must be the positive side which is the making man righteous before God the Father.

While JESUS CHRIST took care of the sin problem *(the negative)* for every human being, He made <u>potential</u> the JUSTIFICATION of all mankind so that fellowship with God the Father would now be possible.

Now, let us first take a look at what Christ did in reference to the negative side of the Gospel

(The Removal of Sin).

20 Christ Came to Save Sinners.

Matthew 9:13

"But go and learn what this means: 'I DESIRE COMPASSION, AND NOT SACRIFICE,' for I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners."

Mark 2:17

And hearing *this*, Jesus *said to them, "*It is* not those who are healthy who need a physician, but those who are sick; I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners."

Luke 5:32

I have not come to call the righteous but sinners to repentance."

John 3:17

¹⁷ "For God did not send the Son into the world to judge the world, but that the world might be saved through Him.

John 12:47

⁴⁷ "If anyone hears My sayings and does not keep them, I do not judge him; for I did not come to judge the world, but to save the world.

1 Timothy 1:15

It is a trustworthy statement, deserving full acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, among whom I am foremost of all.

3

21 He came to give His life for all sinners.

Mark 10:45

"For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

22 He came to save the lost.

Matthew 18:11

11 "For the Son of Man has come to save that which was lost.

Luke 19:10

¹⁰ "For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost."

John 12:46-47

"I have come as Light into the world, so that everyone who believes in Me will not remain in darkness.

⁴⁷ "If anyone hears My sayings and does not keep them, I do not judge him; for I did not come to judge the world, but to save the world.

23 He came bearing the judgment for sins even of all who do not believe in Him.

1 John 2:2

and He Himself is the propitiation for our sins; and not for ours only, but also for *those of* the whole world.

24 He came to taste death for everyone.

Hebrews 2:9

⁹ But we do see Him who was made for a little while lower than the angels, *namely*, Jesus, because of the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, so that by the grace of God He might taste death for everyone.

25 Christ came into the world TO DIE.

John 12:27

"Now My soul has become troubled; and what shall I say, 'Father, save Me from this hour'? But for this purpose I came to this hour. From that time Jesus began to show His disciples that He must go to Jerusalem, and suffer many things from the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised up on the third day.

Mark 8:31

And He began to teach them that the Son of Man must suffer many things and be rejected by the elders and the chief priests and the scribes, and be killed, and after three days rise

Now, let us look at the positive side of the cross, in which He established the potential of imputation of God's Perfect Righteousness to everyone who believes in JESUS CHRIST as Savior.

26 He came to bring joy in heaven over one who believes.

Begins the story of the Prodigal Son, but let us just read the attitude of the Father when that son returns.

Read Luke 15:1-10 and verses 20-24 below

- ²⁰ So he got up and came to his father. But while he was still a long way off, his father saw him and felt compassion *for him*, and ran and embraced him and kissed him.
- And the son said to him, 'Father, I have sinned against heaven and in your sight; I am no longer worthy to be called your son.'
- But the father said to his slaves, 'Quickly bring out the best robe and put it on him, and put a ring on his hand and sandals on his feet;
- ²³ and bring the fattened calf, kill it, and let us eat and celebrate;
- for this son of mine was dead and has come to life again; he was lost and has been found.' And they began to celebrate.

27 He came to be the Savior of the world (Jew and Gentile)

1 John 4:14

- We have seen and testify that the Father has sent the Son <u>to be</u> the Savior of the world.
- 28 He came to make everyone Holy—Faith in JESUS CHRIST is the only way a member of human race can be holy before God.

Hebrews 13:12

- Therefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people—make them holy-- through His own blood, suffered outside the gate.
- 29 But please be ever aware of the fact that JESUS CHRIST came to divide the human race... divide families.

Matthew 10:34-37

- "Do not think that I came to bring peace on the earth; I did not come to bring peace, but a sword.
- "For I came to SET A MAN AGAINST HIS FATHER, AND A DAUGHTER AGAINST HER MOTHER, AND A DAUGHTER-IN-LAW AGAINST HER MOTHER-IN-LAW;

- ³⁶ and A MAN'S ENEMIES WILL BE THE MEMBERS OF HIS HOUSEHOLD.
- ³⁷ "He who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me; and he who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.

Luke 12:49-53

- ⁴⁹ "I have come to cast fire upon the earth; and how I wish it were already kindled!
- ⁵⁰ But I have a baptism to undergo, and how distressed I am until it is accomplished!
- Do you suppose that I came to grant peace on earth? I tell you, no, but rather division;
- for from now on five *members* in one household will be divided, three against two and two against three.
- They will be divided, father against son and son against father, mother against daughter and daughter against mother, mother-in-law against daughter-in-law and daughter-in-law against mother-in-law."

This introduces the Principle of

"Do you have the Courage to Love JESUS CHRIST?"

This Truth may be upsetting to some but it can be great encouragement to many, especially Jews or Muslims who come to know JESUS CHRIST as Savior.

"Comfort One Another with These Words"

30 He came to bring us back to God the Father.

John 13:20

"Truly, truly, I say to you, he who receives whomever I send receives Me; and he who receives Me receives Him who sent Me."

John 14: 6

Jesus *said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me. and might reconcile them both in one body to God through the cross, by it having put to death the enmity.

31 He came to give to everyone who believes on Him Eternal Life.

John 3:14-15

- ¹⁴ As Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up;
- so that whoever believes will in Him have eternal life.

John 6:58

⁵⁸ "This is the bread which came down out of heaven; not as the fathers ate and died; he who eats this bread will live forever."

John 6:40

For this is the will of My Father, that everyone who beholds the Son and believes in Him will have eternal life, and I Myself will raise him up on the last day."

"The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I came that they may have life, and have *it* abundantly.

John 20:30-31

- Therefore many other signs Jesus also performed in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book;
- but these have been written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing you may have life in His name.

1 John 4:9

⁹ By this the love of God was manifested in us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world so that we might live through Him.

John 17:3

This is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.
