# Fall of Greek Empire and Rise of Rome Legs of Iron

It can be argued that the most important empire is the fourth empire, for the Bible spends more verses on the Roman Empire—the legs of Iron.

Note in verse 40 how it is described.

40 "Then there will be a fourth kingdom as strong as iron; This will be Rome inasmuch as iron <u>crushes</u> and <u>shatters all things</u>, so, like iron that <u>breaks in pieces</u>, it will <u>crush and break</u> all these in pieces

The Iron legs represent Rome 1 at its most powerful period.

It will be **Rome** who will crush our Savior on the cross!

But the feet
—made of part iron and part clay—
are used to reveal its weakness and division, in AD 325.

# 10 toes – yet to come

- 41 44 describe what is to occur in the future
- 41 "and in that you saw the feet and toes, partly of potter's clay and partly of iron, it will be a divided kingdom; but it will have in it the toughness of iron, inasmuch as you saw the iron mixed with common clay.

The mixture of iron and clay will be the weakest of all, no cohesiveness in this kingdom

Rome will remain strong until it became so weakened that it split into two separate kingdoms in 325 AD—Eastern part ruled from Constantinople and Western part from Rome.

Both of these parts will become so weak and fall in 476 AD to invaders from the north.

During all this time period, the Jews had forgotten the lessons from God in the Babylonian captivity, and they ignored the wisdom of Daniel to the point that in AD 70 Rome invaded and destroyed both the Temple and the city of Jerusalem, putting all the Jews into diaspora.

## The 10 Toes of clay

42 "As the toes of the feet were partly of iron and partly of pottery, so some of the kingdom will be strong and part of it will be brittle.

#### The 10 toes

—yet to appear in history—

but since all the others have come true we know this will come to be in history in the period of the **Tribulation** or the last seven years of the 390 years promised to Israel.

Then will come the 5<sup>th</sup> and **final**....**The Stone** that will crush the entire Statue, **Kingdom of God with JESUS CHRIST** as its King.

43 and in that you saw the iron mixed with common clay, they will combine with one another in the seed of men; but they will not adhere to one another, even as iron does not combine with pottery.

From a study of the increased inter-marriage of Jews with Gentiles and a study Ezra, this refers to the extreme inter-marriage of cultures and races, which always weakens these cultures and races.

It is so interesting that if we speak of this, we are called racist, but the Muslims who extremely prohibit intermarriage is accepted, just another way Satan seeks to break down this nation and usher in the final nation of the times of the Gentiles.

# The Final Kingdom of JESUS CHRIST The Final Kingdom of the Jews

"In the days of those kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom which will never be destroyed, and that kingdom will not be left for another people; it will crush and put an end to all these kingdoms, but it will itself endure forever.

This verse is so full of information for us today.

First:

we have to determine when this will take place.

Nebuchadnezzar statute starts with him in the 6<sup>th</sup> century bc and will go through the remainder of history through the Millennial reign of Jesus Christ. This verse describes the Second coming of Jesus Christ where He will destroy all the kingdoms of the Gentiles at the end of the Tribulation.

Next:

Which Kingdoms are referred to it will crush and put an end to all these kingdoms

This is a reference to all the kingdoms of the time of the Gentiles... the entire statue.

Remember that IT is described as a single Statue.

There are several references to this event:

#### Dani el 2: 34-35

<sup>34</sup> You continued looking until a stone was cut out without hands, and it struck the statue on its feet of iron and clay and crushed them.
<sup>35</sup> Then the iron, the clay, the bronze, the silver and the gold were crushed all at the same time and became like chaff from the summer threshing floors; and the wind carried them away so that not a trace of them was found. But the stone that struck the statue became a great mountain and filled the whole earth.

#### Daniel 4:3

<sup>3</sup> "How great are His signs

And how mighty are His wonders!

His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom

And His dominion is from generation to generation.

# Stone cut without hands

"In the days of those kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom which will never be destroyed, (in contrast with all the Kingdoms throughout history of man) and that kingdom will not be left for another people; (as has been the course of history it future kingdom of God, the 5<sup>th</sup> Kingdom) will crush and put an end to all these kingdoms, but it will itself endure forever.

- 45 "Inasmuch as you saw that a stone was cut out of the mountain without hands and that it crushed the iron, the bronze, the clay, the silver and the gold, the great God has made known to the king what will take place in the future; so the dream is true and its interpretation is trustworthy."
- 45 "Inasmuch as you saw that a stone (JESUS CHRIST) was cut out (design and purpose) of the mountain (of heaven) without hands (by God)

cut without hands this phrase is used twice to emphasize it's significance.

# **Cut without hands**

human agency.	out

What is going to happen to all the Gentile nations will not be by man but by God Himself.

2 The Principle is found in Ex. 20:25 'If you make an altar of stone for Me, you shall not build it of cut stones, for if you wield your tool on it, you will profane it.

Religions of the world would (—still do—)cut beautiful stones for the altars of their gods –wood, granite even gold,

But when the Israelites made an altar to God, they were not to cut with hands, they were to take the rocks as they were found and not cut or smooth the stones with tools in their hands, but simple stack them as God created them.

# God is <u>not</u> to be worshiped with man's works!

It is amazing how this doctrine

"that God does not want the works of man"

Is all through the bible

beginning with Cain offering God works of his hands

Man insists on offering God the works of his hands

for Salvation, for +Righteousness, for Spirituality, for Blessings.

Yet over and over God insists it will not be by the works of our hands that He saves or blesses.

This is why it is **ALWAYS BY FAITH**, for FAITH relies completely on the works of God's hands.

Inasmuch as you saw that a stone was cut out of the mountain without hands (by God Himself) and that it (the stone, JESUS CHRIST) crushed the iron, the bronze, the clay, the silver and the gold,

This time the statute is described from bottom to top

# The crushing stone is JESUS CHRIST



What is left of the history of man—it may seem as you read history that it is just the same story over and over—rise of nations, fall of nations, but history is headed to the predesigned Plan of God.

This crushing by Stone has not yet occurred, but IT WILL OCCUR after the Church Age--and at end of Tribulation,

JESUS CHRIST our Lord and Savior will return to earth,

not born in a manger, but as a crushing stone

—that will end all the Gentile Nations of history. —

# **JESUS CHRIST the Stone, the Rock of Ages**

1 JESUS CHRIST is called the Rock of our Salvation Deuteronomy 32:15

You are grown fat, thick, and sleek— Then he forsook God who made him, And scorned the Rock of his salvation.

#### **Nebuchadnezzar praises the God of Daniel**

<sup>12</sup> "Then King Nebuchadnezzar fell on his face

This is first said of Abram in Genesis 17:3

Then of Joseph in Genesis 50:1

Then of Moses in Numbers 16:4
Then of Joshua in Joshua 7:6

- <sup>3</sup> Abram fell on his face, and God talked with him, saying,
- Then Joseph fell on his father's face, and wept over him and kissed him.
- When Moses heard this, he fell on his face;
- <sup>6</sup> Then Joshua tore his clothes and fell to the earth on his face before the ark of the LORD until the evening, both he and the elders of Israel; and they put dust on their heads.

and did homage This Arabic verbal stem reveals intensity! You can only imagine what is going on in Nebuchadnezzar. at this time...he has had this horrible, terrifying dream now for sometime and his brilliant staff could not even reveal it, he had reached the point where he was ready to kill them all,

then comes this young Hebrew 17 year old boy who not only tells him his dream but the interpretation of it

...Nebuchadnezzar is awe struck...and he falls down and pays homage. (note that he does not fall down and pay homage not to the God of Daniel) but to Daniel himself.)

Then King Nebuchadnezzar fell on his face and did homage to Daniel, and gave orders to present to him an offering and fragrant incense. We know from verse 30 that Daniel took no credit to himself.

# Things that Nebuchadnezzar learned about the God of Daniel

47 The king answered Daniel and said, "Surely your God is a 1 God of gods and 2 a Lord of kings and

3 a revealer of mysteries, since you have been able to reveal this mystery."

#### But Nebuchadnezzar did not receive JESUS CHRIST as Savior at this time

Verses 48-49

# God promotes in hostility!

48 Then the king promoted Daniel and

1 gave him many great gifts, and

2 he made him ruler over the whole province of Babylon and

3 chief prefect over all the wise men of Babylon.

Look back at verse 6 and you will see that Nebuchadnezzar kept his word, to anyone who told the dream and it's interpretation

## Daniel shares testing and Daniel shares prosperity

We saw that Daniel went to his 3 friends in time of trouble in Daniel 2:17 and they prayed to God together,

Well, now Daniel shares his prosperity with his three friends.

Daniel's wisdom is seen in his relationship with his 3 friends They shared adversity, They shared in prayers to God, and They shared in prosperity.

## You cannot choose your family but you can choose your friends

Grow with them in the Word, Pray for them, Pray with them

# Serve One Another in love

49 And Daniel made request of the king, and he appointed Shadrach, Meshach and Abed-nego over the administration of the province of Babylon, while Daniel was at the king's court.
